



Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District

With the Texas Legislature establishing the Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District on July 19, 2023, the Directors have begun to establish the District and initiate its activities.

The first activity has been to develop a list of Supporters in the Cypress Creek Watershed community. Currently there are 65 non-profit organizations, businesses, individuals, elected officials, churches, hospitals, MUD districts, and others on the Supporter list. This represents a wide range of support for the new District and the desire of the community to participate in flood control future planning.

The objectives of the District are to prepare a comprehensive flood mitigation strategy and a companion funding plan. The flood mitigation strategy will be based on existing engineering studies that have been the basis for current projects being installed by Harris County Flood Control District, studies currently underway by several Houston-area organizations, and updated studies commissioned by the Drainage District. Public meetings are being planned to solicit input from Cypress Creek Watershed constituents in the planning.
