The third Community Workshop will be held in June in the western part of the Cypress Creek watershed. The Q&A and discussion in the first two workshops led to good input on the community's views for flood mitigation. The comments are captured on the website.

The Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District is seeking input from residents, business owners and other stakeholders in the Cypress Creek watershed via an [online survey](#) launched in April.

The online survey is designed to gain input from the community on flood mitigation strategies, flood concerns, top priority projects, the importance of recreational facilities and other flooding-related topics. The CCDID Board will continue to collect survey data through July.

The District's engineering firm, Quiddity Engineering, prepared a draft Framework for a **Cypress Creek Watershed Resiliency Plan**. The plan will be the center point of the District's 2024 report to the Texas Legislature on progress the District has made since its formation in June 2023.
